A WORD from *Pastor Arthur*

When God called me to be the Lead Pastor at Metropolitan Baptist Church over 5 years ago, I never expected to have a year like 2020. It was a chaotic and uncertain year for us as a church, but most of all has left me extremely humbled. In 1 Corinthians 2:5 the Apostle Paul reminds us that, "Our faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." 

